Organising your giving more effectively

By opening an Impact Giving Charity Account, a **single Gift Aid declaration** enables you to distribute your resources to **as many recipients* as you wish**. You tell us who you wish to donate to and we do the rest. It's as simple as that.

The advantages

- Your giving goes further - the taxman adds £28 for every £100 given
- Your giving becomes organised and your beneficiaries do less work
- You can respond to the needs of others as they arise
- You have the option of making part or all of your giving anonymous
- We do not charge you for this service (donations only)

How it works

- You credit your account by standing order or by cheque
- We organise payments to your chosen beneficiaries within the schedule you decide
- You can easily arrange one-off gifts by email (or letter) or by Gift Vouchers
- You receive quarterly account statements, saving you from keeping separate records of each gift
- Tax reclaimed is placed in your account, to be retained or redistributed as you decide

Note that some organisations, such as your local church, and many Christian workers, may not have the charitable status to benefit from the recoverable tax. You can **increase** their income by using our facilities.

You have to pay enough tax in total to cover the amount of tax reclaimed on your giving.

There may be restrictions on support of part-time workers or family members. If this is relevant please contact us.

* The Trust's stated aims are to maximise giving to Christian causes – E.g. churches, Christian workers and other Christian organisations.

Your donations

These are usually set up as a standing order from your bank account, to be paid into your Impact Trust Account on a regular basis. Additional payments may also be made to top-up your balance. Irregular giving is also accepted through cheques or direct bank transfers. We also accept single one-off payments subject to a minimum amount of £50.

Your beneficiaries

Use your account to give more:

- ✓ to your church
- ✓ to mission
- ✓ to Christian workers
- ✓ to those in training for ministry

Because you are in control of your giving, you may alter or stop payments at any time. Single gifts, subject to a minimum of £50, can also be made at any time.

What you receive

Every three months you are supplied with a statement detailing payments in and out of your account, including any tax reclaimed. These statements can be retained as evidence for your own tax returns (higher rate tax payers will pay less at the top rate).

If it is appropriate to your giving, we can provide you with a charity voucher book which will enable you to easily make one-off payments, for example in response to an appeal. You simply give one to a beneficiary, they fill in their details, and we action the payment.

Other information

Tax recovery for regular giving is generally made once or twice a year for the accumulated total of your donations. However, larger or one-off payments are usually reclaimed within 6 weeks after receipt of the payment.

All instructions regarding payments to beneficiaries must be made in writing (via email if you prefer). The application form for the Impact Trust Account contains space for you to supply the initial details of your giving.

The Trust does not charge for its giving services but asks the giver to consider a 2% donation to cover administrative costs.

Receive more from your supporters



Impact Giving (UK) Trust can **increase the income** of Christian workers, churches or organisations by reclaiming tax on your supporters' giving. Currently, for every £100 given, the recoverable tax is £28.

We **reduce your administration** allowing you to get on with your ministry.

Who can benefit?

Christian workers engaged in Bible teaching ministry or evangelism, as well as churches and other Christian organisations. We will also consider applications from those in training for a Christian ministry.

Your supporters

We set up Impact Giving Charity Accounts for your supporters, and recover the tax on donations covered by a Gift Aid declaration, which is on our application form.

They decide how much and how often, and whether to give anonymously. They can also choose to use the account for giving to other Christian beneficiaries. They will receive quarterly statements detailing payments in and out of their account, including any tax reclaimed.

Receiving

Depending on the number of supporters and the amounts involved, we usually collate gifts and transfer them to you as a single payment each month. When a payment has been sent, you will be emailed with the details of its composition, and if requested we can send through a report of your supporters' intent, so you can cross-reference what you are expecting with what you are getting. The names of those giving anonymously will not be disclosed, though you will see their amounts.

Other information

Tax recovery for an individuals giving is generally made once or twice a year for the accumulated total of their donations, though larger or one-off payments are usually reclaimed within eight weeks of the payment. Tax refunds are allocated to your ministry according to the wishes of your supporters.

The Trust does not charge for its giving services but we ask you to encourage your supporters to consider a 2% annual donation to cover our administration costs, which is normally taken from the tax refunds.

Please note that there may be restrictions on support for part-time workers or from family members.

About the Impact Giving (UK) Trust

We are a registered charity that has been offering services for Christian giving for over twenty years. The Trust's aim is to support the spread of the Gospel by all practical means, in particular by channelling donations to Christian beneficiaries such as churches, Christian workers, mission, and relief work.

We are interdenominational and a member of the Evangelical Alliance.
